



Dear CBC Owners –

We have received some good news from the town council of Ft. Myers Beach. As of Friday, May 15th, 2020, the resort can reopen for reservations and occupancy. If you are the owner of a CBC unit in week 20 or beyond, we can have you come out to the resort for your ownership time.

Please note two items of importance:

- The date of May 15th, 2020 is subject to change at any time by the town, so we all will need to monitor the situation closely for full confirmation.
- At this time, you must be a deeded owner to use your unit. We are not yet allowing for reservations or exchanges by guests who are not owners of the unit in the week requested.

There are still social distancing restrictions, as well as restrictions on restaurants and stores as well as some mask requirements depending on where you decide to visit. We also are still restricted in the number of folks that can be gathered as a single group and that impacts the number of folks that can be at the pool, around the picnic tables, shuffleboard, etc.

As we mentioned in our last email message, we are taking aggressive steps at the resort to minimize the risk of virus spread, including enhanced cleaning protocols, closure of the rec room, and stopping in-person gatherings such as the owner meeting, communal breakfast and lunch, and group activities.

Our “new normal” is ever changing and we encourage you to do what is best for YOUR health and safety and for the health and safety of your family. You are always welcome to leverage our new exchange program with Tricom (Platinum Interchange) to use your time later in this year or even in years to come when there are fewer restrictions.
